Pinewoods Scottish Sessions Packing List

- Flashlight with extra batteries (the paths can be very dark at night)
- Blankets and sheets (for single beds) or a sleeping bag; linens and towels can be rented from Camp for a nominal fee
- Extra pillow (PCI provides one per person)
- Towels (plural): for swimming and beach activities, showers, and hand drying; they take a long time to dry in humid weather
- · Swimsuit, scent-free sunscreen, sunglasses, sunhat
- Comfortable clothes for dancing during the day (lots of t-shirts, skirts or shorts; sundresses) and night (typically dresses or skirts, shorts, or kilts with festive short-sleeved or sleeveless shirts)
- Extra changes of socks and underwear for the warm weather
- Ball gowns, kilts with Prince Charlie, or other finery (encouraged for the balls)
- Shoes: all your ghillies, pumps, dance sneakers, etc.; comfortable sturdy shoes for walking around camp, flip-flops for pondside and showers
- Costumes and accessories for the tea party in Session I and costume dance in Session II (optional but welcome)
- · Warm clothing, such as jeans and a sweatshirt (the weather gets cool sometimes, especially at night)
- Rain gear and/or umbrellas (this helps keep the rain away!)
- Insect repellent—scent free!
- Toothpaste, toothbrush, scent-free toiletries (all showers have scent-free body wash, shampoo, and conditioner provided)
- Bathrobe for walking to the shower
- Fans—both hand-held for the dance floor and electric for the cabin
- Alarm clock or other wake-up device (not everyone hears the bagpipes!)
- · Charging cables (long) for your electronics
- · Medications you may need, especially a bee sting kit if you are allergic; band-aids
- Covid tests (minimum 3 for Session I and 4 for Session II)
- High-filtration masks (minimum 5-10; N95, KN95, etc)
- Special foods you may need (you may use the refrigerators in the Camp House, Pinecones, and Hunsdon House)
- Musical instruments
- Beer and other beverages to enjoy and share (punch is usually provided at parties—both spiked and unspiked)
- Water bottle(s); travel mug for hot beverages (outside the Dining Hall)
- · Small carry-all or backpack for bringing your shoes and water bottles around camp
- Cash or checks to open an account with the Camp Store and donate to Pinewoods
- Items to donate to the auctions to support Pinewoods (optional but appreciated)

DO NOT bring:

- Pets
- Guests
- Valuables
- Firearms
- Illegal substances
- Scented products such as perfume, after-shave, etc.
- Heat-producing appliances such as hairdryers. Most of the housing at camp cannot handle the electrical requirements of hairdryers. If you must use them, when at camp ask the Grounds Crew where these appliances can be used safely.
