Driving Directions

From Eastern Vermont:

Take Interstate 91 north or south to Exit 15. Travel east 200 yards on Lake Morey Road. Turn left on U.S. Route 5 north. Travel ½ mile to center of town. Fairlee Town Hall is on the left, behind the bandstand.

From Southern N.H.:

Take Interstate 93 north to Interstate 89. Take Interstate 89 north to Interstate 91. Follow directions from eastern Vermont.

Mary Kate's Super-Symmetric Symmetry-Breaking Strathspey

or

Mary Kate's Strathspey

32 bar strathspey for 3 couples

- 1 – 4** 1st couple giving right hands cross (down) below 2nd couple & cast up to 1st place on opposite sides
- 4 – 12** 1st & 2nd couples dance diamond poussette (1st couple begins and ends on opposite sides)
- 13 – 16** 2nd couple giving left hands cross (up) above 1st couple & cast down to 2nd place on opposite sides
- 17 – 20** Set & link modified: on bars 19-20 1w & 2m giving left hands in passing end facing their (casting) partners on the 1st corner diagonal to flow into
- 21 – 28** a diagonal reel of 4, which flows into
- 29 – 32** 4 hands round to the left (a bit more than once round, with 1m leading 1w & 2w leading 2m)

Repeat from new position

Mary Kate Adami-Sampson was a beloved member of the Boston Branch whose passing from this world in the Autumn of 2009 was far too early. Christopher Anagnostakis wrote this Strathspey to honor our friend. The diamond poussette was one of her favorite figures.
