**Scottish Country Dancing is set dancing; that is, it's done in sets of several couples, usually four. Individuals interact with partners, corners, and others in the set, using several figures to make up each dance. The figures are interesting, and simple footwork lends an element of grace and style. Participants usually change partners after every dance.**



**Scottish Country Dancing has historical roots, having evolved from court dancing of the 16<sup>th</sup> century. It has since become a structured form of social dance enjoyed by all.**



**Join the fun, complete with whoops and hollers during jigs and reels, punctuated by stately strathspeys. Young and old, singles and couples are all welcome.**
