

Pinewoods Scottish Sessions

Please arrive after 3 pm the first day of the session and leave by 10 am on the last day. Those attending Sessions I and II may stay through the day on Monday, July 12.

Although no dress code is enforced, the norm for classes and parties is the kilt for men and a skirt for women. If you plan to participate in Highland or Step dance classes, bring clothing that can be worn while stretching on the floor.

Pets, illegal drugs, and firearms are NOT allowed. Heat producing appliances are permitted only in certain locations due to wiring limitations. Consult with the manager before using hairdryers or irons or the like or your half of camp may suddenly find itself without power. If you bring valuables, please remember that neither Pinewoods Camp nor the RSCDS Boston Branch can assure their safety or be responsible for them.

A suggested checklist of things to bring follows. When packing, remember that there are no laundry facilities at camp. The nearest shopping and laundromat are about a fifteen minute drive from camp. The camp store does carry ice, snacks and soft drinks.

Essentials:

- Bedding or sleeping bag (Pinewoods only provides a mattress and pillow)
- Towels
- Beach towel
- Bathing suit(s)
- Warm clothes (for cool evenings or chilly days)
- Party clothes, formal and informal
- Sturdy shoes (for wooded paths)***
- Dance shoes (all the pairs you have)
- Food for special dietary needs
- Food and beverages for parties
- Flashlight and batteries***
- Rain gear
- Alarm clock
- Insect repellent
- Medications
- Toiletries
- Checkbook

Extras:

- Ceilidh props and costumes for special parties/events (themes will be posted with acceptances)
- Musical instruments
- Camera
- Items for the Chinese auction (Session I)
- Items for the traditional auction (Session II)
- Games, puzzles, party entertainment
- Items for the Scottish Exchanges – Scottish clothes or artifacts
- Mats for yoga (Block and Belt if you have them)
