Final Waltz

Directions to Kennebunk Town Hall – Take exit 25 on the Maine Turnpike (Rt.95). Turn left onto Rt. 35, east to Kennebunk. When Rt. 35 crosses Rt. 1, go left on Rt. 1 for one block. Turn right onto a narrow street immediately before the Town Hall. Parking is on the right. For more information please contact Merrill before Saturday at 207-409-9050 or crone4702@gmail.com.

Limited hospitality is available. Pot luck supper at 5.30 pm at 20 Cottagewood Lane, Kennebunk, ME 04043, the home of Joanne Hulsey and Peter Sentner. Directions are on the reverse.

All attendees must be fully vaccinated against Covid or have tested negative within 6 hours of the event. Masks will most likely be optional.









Directions to potluck:

From the south and west: Rt.95 (Maine Turnpike) to Exit 19 (Wells). Turn left on to Rt. 9. At Wells Corner, turn left onto Rt. 1 (it is still also Rt. 9). Soon after the Maine Diner, bear right still on Rt. 9. After a traffic light at the intersection of Rt. 9 and Sea Rd. take the first street on the left, Cottagewood Lane. # 20 is on the mailbox.

From the north: Rt. 95 (Maine Turnpike) to Exit 25 (Kennebunk). Turn left onto Rt. 35. At the roundabout, make sure to stay left on Rt. 35. At the traffic light, turn left onto Rt. 1 but get into the right lane to continue on Rt. 35, past the Town Hall where the dance is. At the first traffic light on Rt. 35 turn right onto Sea Rd. and continue on this until you come to a 2nd traffic light at the intersection of Rt. 9 and Sea Rd. Turn left and take the first street on the left. See above.

The Daancing Dutchman 32R, 3C:

- 1-8 1s & 2s dance right hands across halfway while 3s cross right hand, all chase halfway clockwise back to own sides, all set
- 9-16 1st woman dances left shoulder reel on side with 1st and 2nd men, she crosses below 2nd man to begin, on 15-16 1st woman crosses back to 2nd place own side while 1st and 2nd men change places passing left shoulder (Red House reel)
- 17-24 1st man dances right shoulder reel on side with 1st and 2nd women, he crosses below 2nd woman to begin, on 23-24, 1st man crosses to 3rd place own side while 1st & 2nd women change places passing right shoulder (Red House reel) (321)
- 25-32 3rd and 2nd couples set and link, 3rd and 1st couples set and link ending 213 ready to begin again.

The Royal Tea Party 32S, 2C:

- 1-8 1s & 2s, facing diagonally, set, advance [1 step], retire [1 step], cast one position clockwise, turn partner (both hands) 3/4. Finish in line across
- 9-16 1s & 2s set, dance a half reel of 4, turn halfway with both hands
- 17-24 1s & 2s set, dance a half reel of 4. 1st man, followed by his partner, dance across into 2nd place WHILE 2nd woman, followed by her partner, dance across into 1st place
- 25-32 1st man, followed by his partner, dance up behind 2nd man and down the middle, pulls back his RSh and turns his partner with both hands 1+1/4 to own sides

Morven's Garden 32S, 3C:

- 1-8 1st couple dance mirror reels on their own sides with the 2nd & 3rd couples, taking hands whenever possible. To begin, 1st couple dance in and down, 2nd couple dance out and up, and 3rd couple dance in and up. 1st and 2nd couples end in the center facing each other up and down the dance, near hands joined.
- 9-16 1st and 2nd couples dance a rondel; on the last 2 bars (bars 15-16), the first couple cross to 2nd place opposite sides facing each other.
- 17-28 2nd, 1st, and 3rd couples dance rights and lefts for 3 couples.
- 29-32 First couple dance half figure of eight to end in 2nd place, own sides, the woman down around the 3rd woman and the man up around the 2nd man.
