B. Concert 2023 budget (Cathy and Linda)

- vi. We are paying Hanneke \$500 base, and as long as we hit 75% attendance, we will share profits.
- vii. We are applying for a grant from NH Scot to help keep ticket prices lower.
- viii.Budget approved.
